2009 Grant Guidelines

The 2009 grant is for projects occurring between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009.

Foundation Objectives

- Educate the citizens of Alabama about the contribution forests make to the environmental quality and economy of Alabama.
- Promote healthy and productive rural and urban forests, clean water, and abundant wildlife.

Application Information

- The maximum grant amount is \$10,000.
- Applicants will be notified of approval by January 2009.
- The Foundation reserves the right to approve or disapprove any part or all of a proposal.
- Return the completed proposal to the address listed above postmarked no later than **November 1, 2008**.

Additional Requirements

- A final written report, including receipts of expenses and copies of any publicity the project receives must be forwarded to the Foundation at the address above by January 31, 2010. Deadline extensions will be considered on a case by case basis. Such extensions must be requested in writing before the report deadline.
- Previous recipients are ineligible for the 2009 grant until the Foundation has received and accepted any outstanding grant reports. Every report is subject to an independent review.
- Grant recipients are responsible for compliance with all state and federal tax laws.
- Grant recipients must acknowledge the Alabama Forests Forever Foundation as a co-sponsor in all articles, press releases, signage or other advertisements in conjunction with the project(s).
